I know that many people have asked after Miss Caygill. You will all be pleased to hear that she is recovering well from her surgery and I know that you will join us all in sending her our very best wishes.



PE days for Autumn Term.

Children are asked to come to school in their PE kits on PE Days with appropriate length shorts and suitable footwear. The PE days are as follows:

Swimming lessons for Years 3, 4, 5 & 6

As part of the national curriculum, children in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 will start their annual swimming lessons at Catterick Leisure Centre on Wednesday 10 September 2025. This is a ten week block and the last lessons will take place on 19 November 2025 (there will be no lesson Wednesday 29 October due to half-term).

The total cost of these lessons (including instructors and transport) is £3,078.63. In order to help reduce the cost of the parental contribution as much as possible, the PFTA has kindly donated £600 and £680 has been paid for via the Sports Grant.

The school receives no extra funding for the swimming curriculum, and we are therefore requesting a parental contribution of £75.00 for the 10 week lessons (£7.50 per week) via your child's Parent Pay account. The contribution can be made in full or instalments set by the parent by Friday 31 October 2025.

A paper consent was sent out on Wednesday 3rd /4th September 25 via book bags, and we would be grateful if it could be returned by Monday 8th September 25 prior to the 1st swimming lesson next week.

Pupils that usually have school bus transport home will need to be collected by parents at 4.00 pm as last year.
