EYFS-Induction Questionnaire

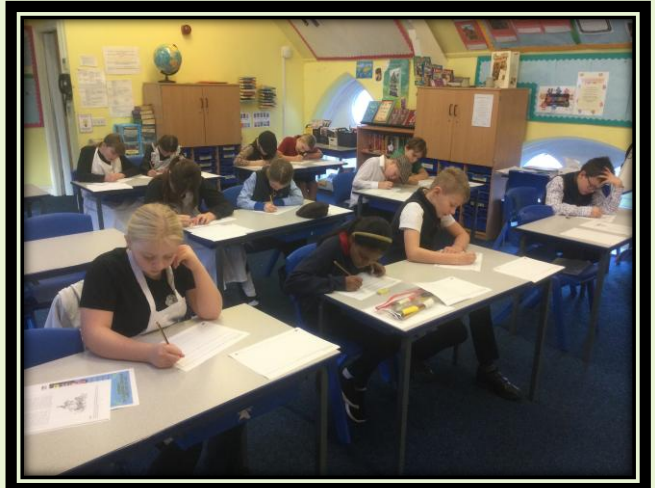
