The Chair (Emma B) Treasurer (Lindsey Whaley) and Secretary (Anna Fagg) all offered to stay in their roles, this was unanimously approved by all present.

**Finances** – The current account balance is £3830.57 and saving account balance is £1003.99. There is still a cheque for £1020 for Fosters coaches to come out of the current account. This was posted yesterday (6<sup>th</sup> Nov). Overall there is £2810 remaining. Allocation for the coming year was discussed based on the current account balance and it was decided we could offer £300 per class for the trip, £300 for a year 6 leavers trip and £500 toward the class 2 residential.

Christmas Fair – Saturday 30th November in The Market Hall 10am – 4pm

Raffle – Including prizes from the 13 stall holders booked, there are more than 30 prizes for the raffle in addition to the £100 first prize so it was decided not to go around the local businesses this year.

- 1 for entry and raffle tickets

AF to put a piece in the newsletter asking for help, baking, wine and chocolate. Dalesplay are going to save empty bottles from their fair this weekend.

Still need to get glitter and foam shapes for the decorated jars – AF to organise. Also print date protection info from Post Office site and Santa's address for the kids to copy.

LW will organise mince pies – check dates are adequate to see us through Christmas production if necessary.

EB will ask for donations of cups and lids. KI will ask for donations of tea/coffee/sugar.

Gadge has offered to donate pork, James will cook on the Friday. KW is making two pans of soup which the White Heart are donating.

It was discussed and decided to do hot dogs instead of sausage rolls – AF will check the cupboard to see how many we have. Use the pulled pork buns cut in half.
