

Christmas Fair -

AF has completed the application for an occasional sale license - ref:101009700229 14.11.22

Trade Stalls – Information and booking forms sent to 15 stall holders including 5 doubles. Confirmation and payment from 4. AF to chase others and check with Sharon who was collecting forms from the ladies who attend her regular sales.

AC to check with Di if school need a stall for tote bags? Possibly combine with second hand uniform stall. SD-C is collecting uniform from Dawn and sorting before the event. Sell uniform at £1 an item.

AF drew up a rough table plan - some of Sharon's ladies have requested specific places as they are staying on for a sale on the Sunday too. Fudge lady may need to move to accommodate the raffle.

Raffle – returns quite slow at the moment. AF to put reminder in the newsletter this week about returning tickets sold or not.

AA has secured vouchers as prizes from Wensleydale Ice cream (CS to chase up), Forbidden Corner, Black Sheep Brewery, The Wensleydale Heifer. The Chippie and The Pantry will also donate a voucher. Wensleydale creamery are donating a hamper which AF will collect the day before.

Wine and Water – Joanne Fothergill has saved 38 empty bottles from the Dalesplay fair at the weekend and is storing for us. LW will ask Ann at The Board to save more bottles. Request for full wine bottles to go in newsletter this week.

Guess the number of bottle tops in the jar – game for the adults – Chris Taplin has offered to donate a bottle of spirit for the prize – AA to collect
